CapitaLand Hope Foundation (CHF), the philanthropic arm of CapitaLand Group was established in 2005. CHF has been supporting seniors to age in place through their #LoveOurSeniors initiative that seeks to provide them with better nutrition, enhanced well-being and improved living conditions. Since 2018, over \$5 million has been committed to-date in support of various initiatives, benefitting over 80,000 seniors in Singapore.

CHF has journeyed with TOUCH Community Services for the last five years in the following initiatives:

- Creating inclusive spaces for the community to interact, integrate and improve their quality of life by partially supporting the infrastructural cost for TOUCHpoint@AMK 433 with \$400,000
- Sponsored and delivered 7,900 environmentally friendly care packs to frail seniors in 2021 and 2022 during the pandemic
- Worked with TOUCH to visit 23 homes in 2021 and 2022 to befriend and identify the needs of seniors and subsequently mobilised staff volunteers to declutter and improve the homes, creating a safer and conducive living environment for the seniors

CHF believes in uplifting the communities in good and tough times and has moved swiftly to support the immediate needs of communities affected by COVID-19 including contribution of \$700,000 to AIC, through Community Foundation of Singapore's (CFS) Sayang Sayang Fund, to support Community Care partners, affected seniors and staff.

In 2022, CHF contributed \$350,000 to support FUN! Fund set up by AIC and CFS, to encourage and empower community care organisations to innovate and develop fun impactful programmes that enable seniors to be socially connected and enhanced personal well-being.

Beyond donations, CapitaLand also advocates volunteerism among its staff and leverages on its network to rally the community to reach out to those in need. More than 700 staff volunteers, 2,000 tenant and community volunteers contributed their time towards #LoveOurSeniors initiative.
