Giving back to society and helping the less fortunate has since been an integral part of MUS Zenith Affair and has a special place in the heart of its founder, Ms Esther Ho. Over the last three years, MUS Zenith Affair has continuously fundraised for DSG during each anniversary, with the amount raised totalling \$488,000 to date, through:

- A Social media campaign #BringASparkleBackToTheirEyes in 2020, which is extended from one to two months during the peak of the pandemic
- Produced a coffee-table book titled 'Gems of Memories' in 2021 with heart-warming and inspiring stories from the charity ambassadors and supporters of the brand
- Organised 2 fundraising campaigns for 'Stories of Inspiration Gems of Memories' and a Charity Gala Dinner themed 'Gems for Generations' in 2022

Their fundraising efforts continues, and Esther is looking forward to the next fundraising this November.
