PAP Community Foundation Sparkletots Preschool (PCF Sparkletots) is a preschool operator with over 350 preschools. Since 2017, Agency for Integrated Care (AIC) has been partnering with PCF Sparkletots to foster regular intergenerational activities between the preschools and the seniors from the Community Care Organisations (CCOs). The collaboration has grown to include 177 Sparkletots Preschool Centres collaborating with 59 CCOs.

Due to COVID, physical visits to the CCOs were postponed. As restrictions were gradually lifted, PCF Sparkletots and the CCOs re-started non-physical and virtual activities that include:

- Co-creating activities between children and seniors. For example, children providing a drawing for seniors to colour and vice versa, with the final products displayed at the preschool or CCO
- Recording videos of children's performances and sharing them during virtual activities with seniors
- The children and seniors exchanged handmade festive crafts, which were used as decoration at their premises.
- Conducting virtual activities, where the children prepare materials and guide seniors to complete the activities, encouraging intergenerational bonding.
- Parents and children contributed and packed care packs for seniors and CCO staff

Over the past three years, PCF Sparkletots brought 760 hours of fun and joy to the seniors at various CCOs. In February 2021, AIC and PCF renewed their commitment to the Community Care sector for another three years through a Memorandum of Understanding.
